Vaccines for Children (VFC)

The Cerro Gordo County Department of Public Health Immunization Clinic is a Vaccines for Children (VFC) provider. Through state funding, the VFC program provides **FREE** vaccines to your child if they meet any of the following criteria:

The child must be 18 or younger AND:

- have no health insurance coverage.
- be American Indian or Alaskan Native.
- be enrolled in Medicaid (Medicaid Greencard, Medicaid HMOs, Medipass Gatekeeper program, and Medicaid as secondary health coverage).
- be under-insured. This means the child's health insurance does not cover the cost of immunizations.
