Health Department Hosts Saturday Flu Clinic

(Mason City) — The Cerro Gordo County Department of Public Health will host a flu clinic this Saturday, November 19, 2016 from 9:00AM to Noon located at the Health Department Immunization Clinic in Mohawk Square.

“Saturday flu clinics are a convenient way for individuals that don’t have the opportunity to attend our standard weekly or evening flu clinics to still get vaccinated,” said Jennifer Stiles, Infectious Disease Nurse, Cerro Gordo County Department of Public Health. “We strive to make our services available for all residents to further protect our community from the flu.”

The Health Department will be offering the following types of flu vaccine:

- Traditional flu shot (4 strains) \$35
- High-dose flu shot (ages 65 and older) \$57
- Pneumonia Vaccine \$111
- PCV 13 \$205

The Health Department accepts most major health insurances. With insurance, no money is collected at the time of the vaccination; services are billed directly to insurance. Any remaining balance is billed to the client after insurance has paid for its portion of the service.
