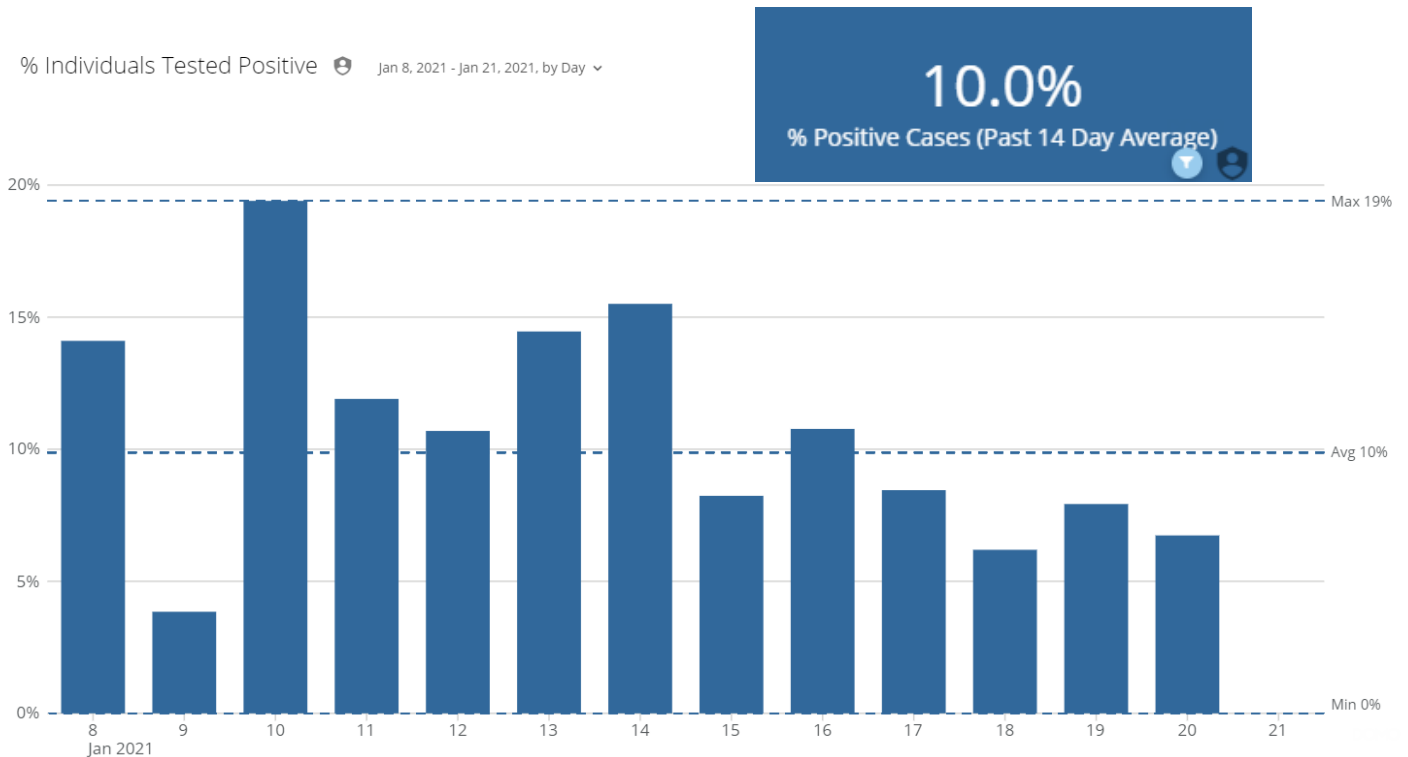
## COVID-19 Joint Information Center Update

### Data Snapshot (as of 10:00am)

- 310,596 total lab-confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Iowa (01/22/2021).
  - 4,708 total lab-confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cerro Gordo (01/22/2021).
  - 4,211 total recovered in Cerro Gordo (01/22/2021).
  - 425 total active cases in Cerro Gordo (01/22/2021).
- 4,478 deaths in Iowa (01/22/2021).
  - 72 deaths in Cerro Gordo (01/22/2021).

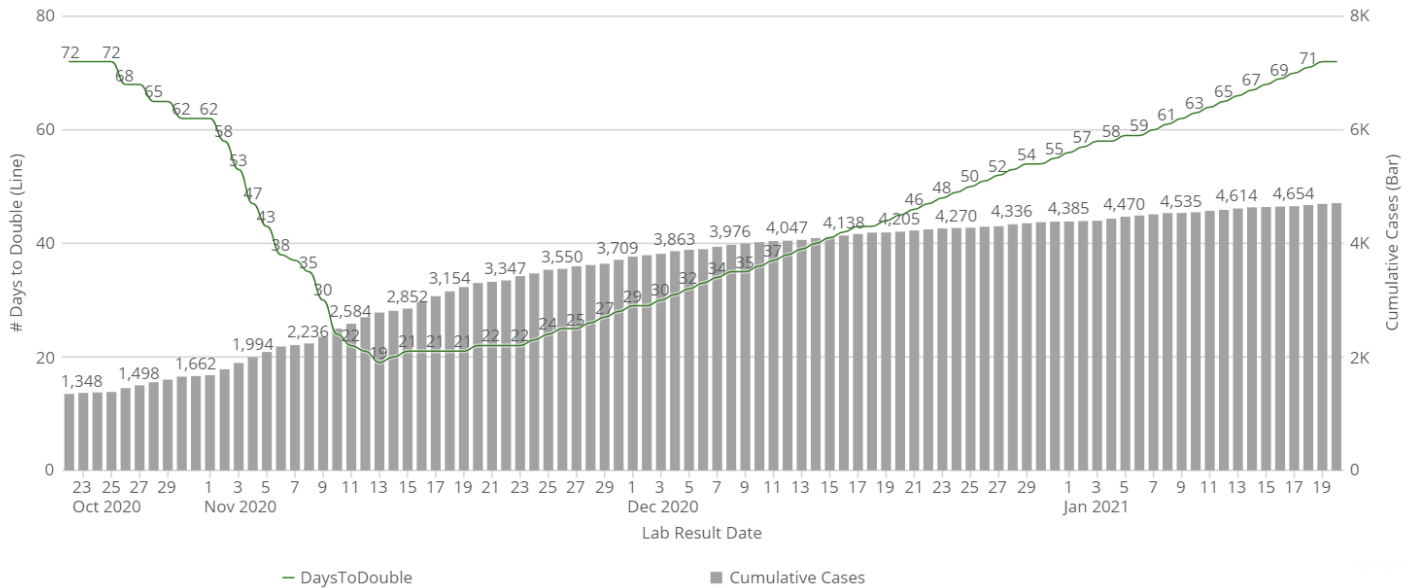


### Days to Double
