COVID-19 Joint Information Center Update

Data Snapshot (as of 10:00am)

- 390,591 total lab-confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Iowa (04/21/2021).
 - 5,642 total lab-confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cerro Gordo (04/21/2021).
 - 4,992 total recovered in Cerro Gordo (04/21/2021).
- 5,899 deaths in Iowa (04/21/2021).
 - 87 deaths in Cerro Gordo (04/21/2021).
- 4.2% - 14-day positivity rate in Cerro Gordo (04/21/2021).
- 160 – days to double in Cerro Gordo (04/21/2021).
