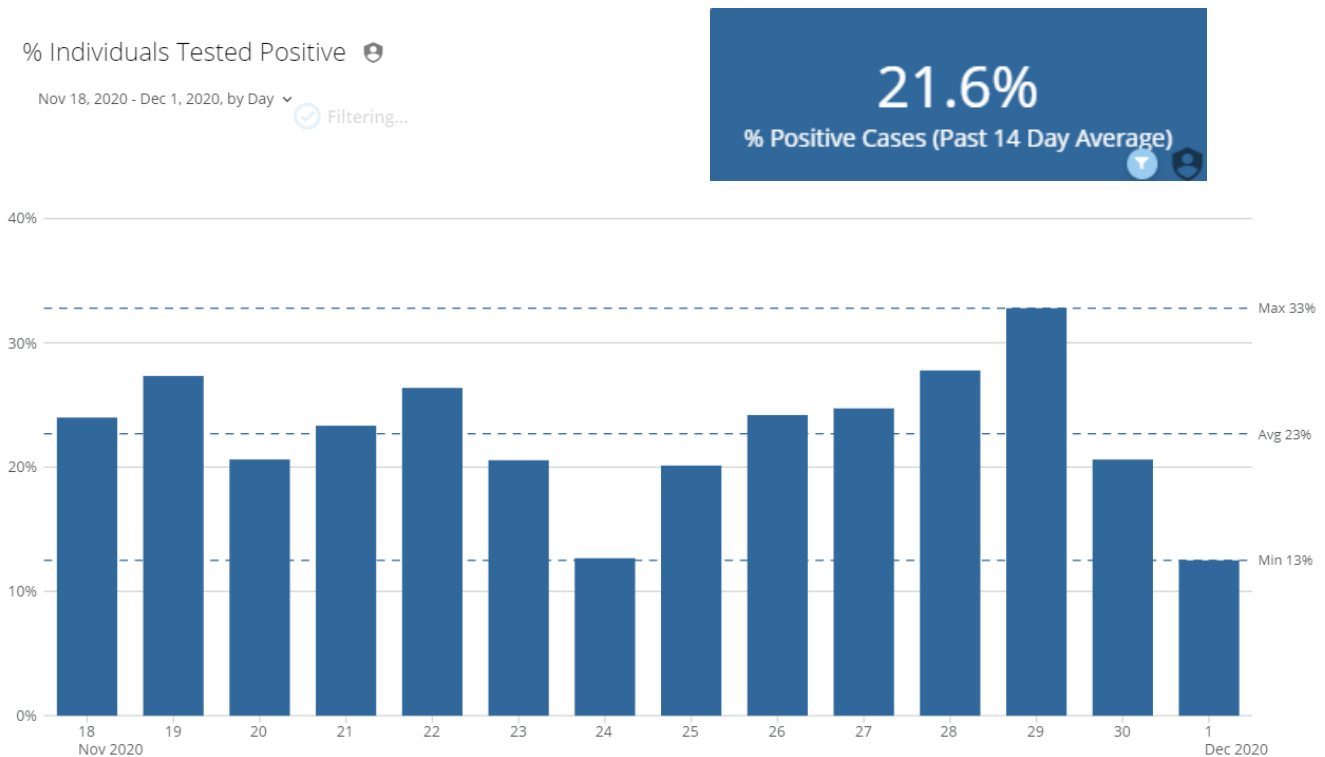
COVID-19 Joint Information Center Update

Data Snapshot

- 233,866 total lab-confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Iowa (12/01/2020).
 - 3,658 total lab-confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cerro Gordo (12/01/2020).
 - 1,845 total recovered in Cerro Gordo (12/01/2020).
 - 1,765 total active cases in Cerro Gordo (12/01/2020).
- 2,449 deaths in Iowa (12/01/2020).
 - 48 deaths in Cerro Gordo (12/01/2020).
