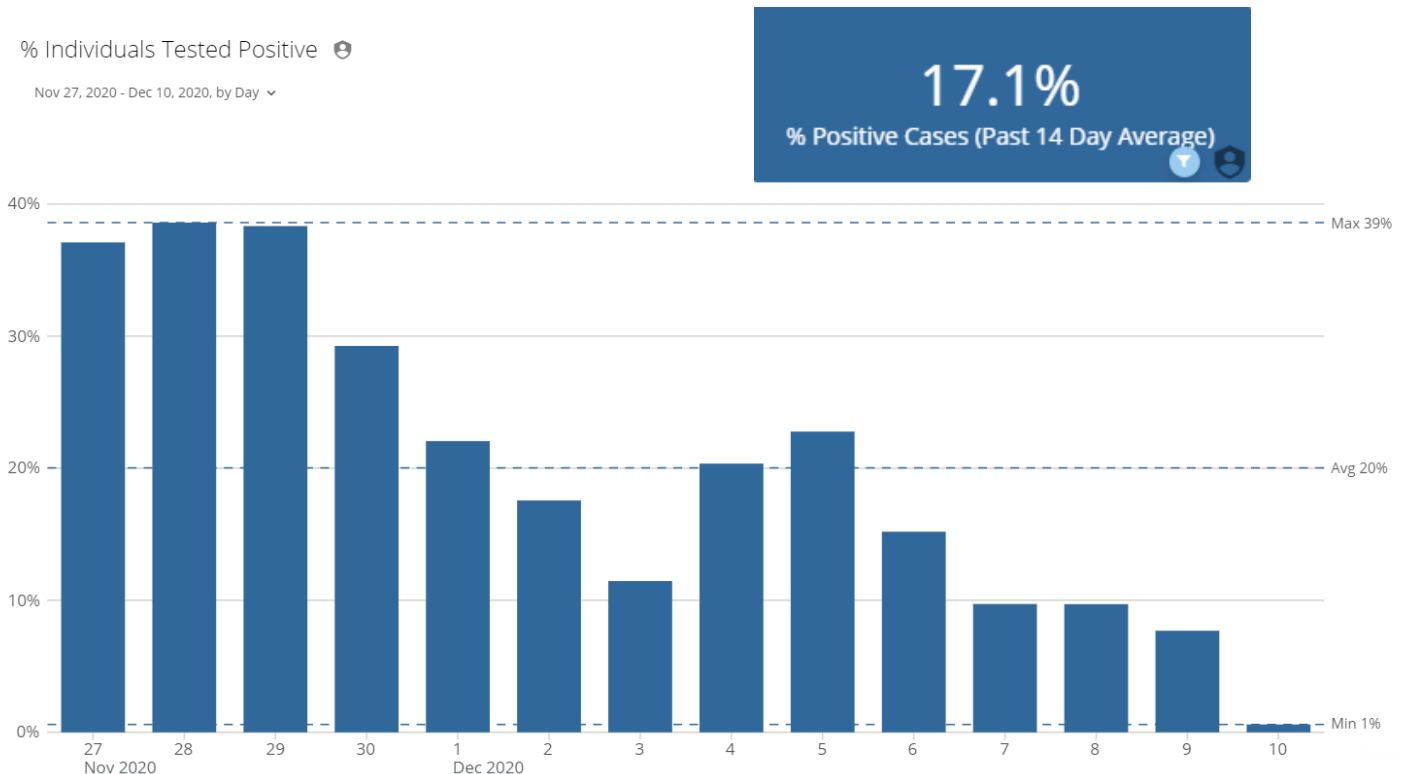
COVID-19 Joint Information Center Update

Data Snapshot (as of 10:00am)

- 253,085 total lab-confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Iowa (12/11/2020).
 - 3,952 total lab-confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cerro Gordo (12/11/2020).
 - 2,632 total recovered in Cerro Gordo (12/11/2020).
 - 1,271 total active cases in Cerro Gordo (12/11/2020).
- 3,197 deaths in Iowa (12/11/2020).
 - 49 deaths in Cerro Gordo (12/11/2020).

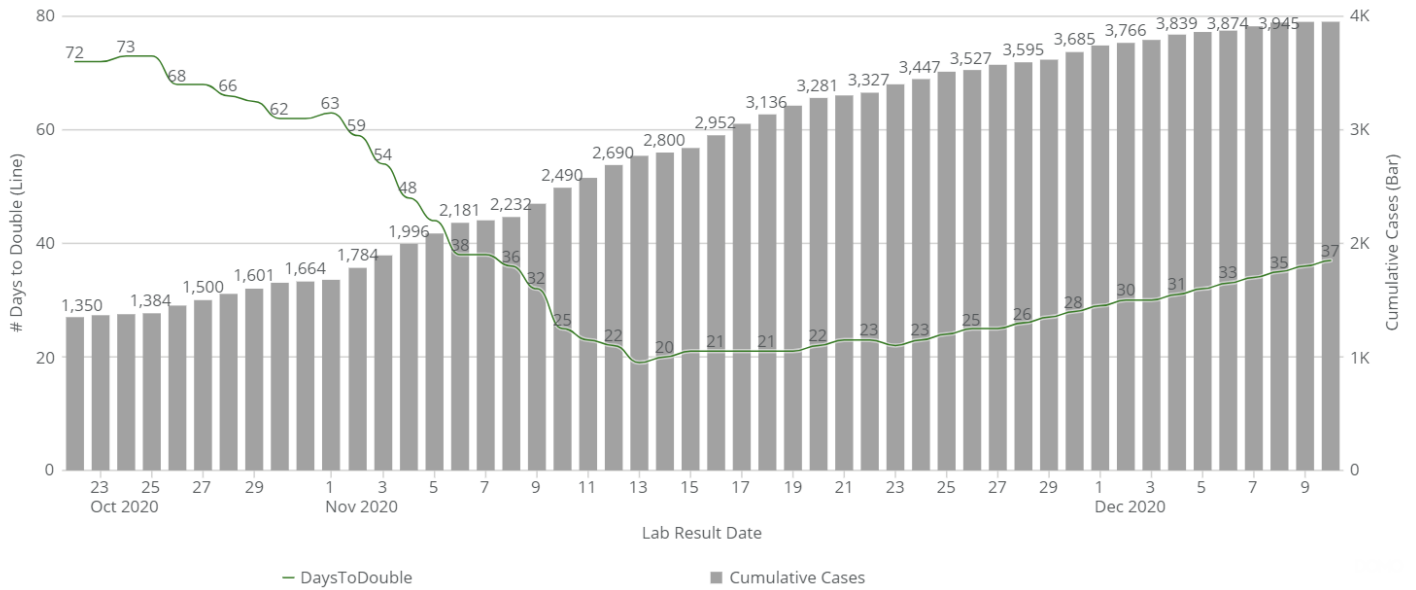


Days to Double
